Job Title: National Technical Director (DTN) of the Swimming Federation

Job Description: The National Technical Director is a highly skilled expert with in-depth knowledge of the sports disciplines governed by World Aquatics regulations. Reporting to the Vice-President, Secretary General of the FLNS, or any other designated authority as determined by the statutes or the Board of Directors, the National Technical Director serves as the hierarchical authority for national coaches across all aquatic disciplines under the FLNS, overseeing and coordinating their activities.

This role involves planning, directing, and managing the FLNS's sports activities while navigating a complex landscape of sporting, legal, media, social, economic, and professional challenges. As such, the position requires expertise as a coach, negotiator, visionary, and communicator.

Key Responsibilities:

- Development and implementation of sports strategies
- Supervising the organization of competitions and national teams
- Training and development of managers, coaches, and officials
- Coordination of actions between the FLNS and affinity sports federations, school and university sports, and military sports
- Ensuring consistency of the Federation's sports projects with the guidelines of the Ministry of Sport and the Luxembourg Olympic Committee

- Oversee, organize, and advance all technical and sporting activities within the Swimming Federation, including competitive swimming, water polo, artistic swimming, diving, open water swimming, and Masters events
- Execute the federation's sports policy and support affiliated clubs
- Develop, refine, and implement the "FLNS Method" for performance research
- Establish criteria for the national team, including access requirements, selection process, qualification standards, and retention policies
- Supervise and coordinate the training center and elite training and expertise center
- Lead coach education programs and "Learn to Swim" initiatives
- Support clubs with training, consulting services, and promotional activities

- Experience in a similar or elite-level coaching role is an asset
